



Care and Cleaning Instructions Natural Stone Surfacing

Your Heritage Marble Natural Stone Surfacing has been fabricated by skilled craftsman using premium quality tools and materials. You can protect the beauty of your Natural Stone product and ensure a long life of trouble-free service by observing the following suggestions.

GENERAL CARE AND CLEANING

Natural Stone surfaces are easy to clean using a soft cloth with warm water and any pH neutral, non-abrasive cleaner or mild dishwashing detergent. Be sure to rinse with clear water when complete, as too much cleaner or soap may leave a film and/or cause streaks when the surface dries.

In wet areas, soap scum can be minimized by using a squeegee after each use. To remove soap scum, use a non-acidic soap scum remover or a solution of ammonia and water (about 1 cup of ammonia to 1 gallon of water). Take note that frequent or over-use of an ammonia solution may eventually dull the surface of the stone.

Certain chemical substances can seriously mar your product's finish, even during brief periods of contact. Protect your Tower Industries Natural Stone Surfacing from these harmful compounds:

- Clorox® and other Hydrochlorite Bleaches
- Oven Cleaner (or any other alkaline cleaners)
- Comet® (or any other abrasive cleaners)
- Tarnish Removers and Silver Cleaners
- S.O.S. ® Pads and all similar abrasive products
- Paint Strippers containing Methylene Chloride
- Soft Scrub® (or any other product containing pumice)
- Lemon Juice or Vinegar (or any other solution containing acids)

Take note that many common foods and drinks contain acids that may dull your Natural Stone Surface. The use of coasters, trivets, and placemats is ALWAYS recommended.

DO NOT apply any waxes, penetrants, or other topical treatments to your Tower Industries Natural Stone Surfacing under any circumstances.

GENERAL INFORMATION

1. All Natural Stone surfaces can be damaged by excessive force or pressure.
2. Natural Stone surfaces can be damaged by sudden and rapid temperature changes, especially near the edges, as well as direct or sustained heating of the product. Your product may not withstand the direct transfer of heat from hot pots and pans, electric frying pans and griddles, some crock pots, some toasters and toaster ovens, and heat lamps. Therefore, the use of a hot pad or trivet is ALWAYS recommended.
